Announcing the International Demonstration for GMO-free foods across the World. The Demonstration is held as a March which leads from Zuerich, (Schwamendinger Platz) to the Swiss Research Facility ?Reckenholz? which is open field testing GE potatoes and genetically modified wheat.

Testing is allowed until october of 2019.

The potatoes planted are genetically modified to withstand blight.

The idea and crop comes from the Netherlands where scientists took the responsible genes that protect the plant from a wild variety of the potato and merged it with the conventional potato.

In times passed the research center Reckenholz, in close proximity to the city of Zuerich, used to be a place well spoken of in the scientist community und conventional wheat crops were raised very successfully.
